Sue Ella Lee Cooke went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, May 1, 2014. She was 97 years old. She was born to the late Thomas Mason and Blanche Rivers on February 25, 1917, in Sussex County, VA. Her older sister, Atha Virginia Mason preceded her in death. She worked the majority of her life providing domestic support for several families in the Seaford Area. Mother Cooke was a faithful member of the Church of God. She served as an Usher, a member of the Women's Choir, Communion Committee, a Sunday School Assistant Teacher, culminating as Mother of the Church. Sue Ella never sought a title or recognition, but distinguished herself through exuberant love for her Lord and Savior and an overwhelming capacity to love everyone. She embodied the spirit of "Peace". Sue Ella is survived by six children, Blanche Mitchell, George D. Cooke (Cornelia), Clinton E. Cooke (Amira), Joseph A. Cooke, Sr. (Aletha), Alvin W.
