## Obituary of Mr. Roland Paul Placente:

Roland Paul "Pee Wee" Placente, 74, of Dagsboro and formerly of Burlington Township, NJ passed away at home on June 2, 2016. He was a graduate of Burlington City High School, in 1959 and enlisted in the US Coast Guard serving for four years.
