**D**aniel Gregory Mifflin, of Georgetown, passed away on January 23, 2018 at Kent General Hospital. He was 61 years of age.

Daniel, affectionately known as Danny, was born on July 11, 1956 in Milford Delaware to Lula Mifflin (Rowley). He attended Sussex Central High.
