Joseph H. Kamrad, 72, passed away Friday, September 14, 2018. Born in Trenton, NJ, Mr. Kamrad was a longtime resident of Pennington NJ. He worked as a Supervisor of Investigations for the State of NJ DMAHS/Human Services and upon retiring moved to Lewes DE.

Mr. Kamrad was a proud veteran of the United States Air Force and served in the Vietnam War. He was an active member of the community and coached T-ball, YMCA Basketball and Little League Baseball.
