**J**oseph A. "Bud" Moore, Jr. of Gumboro, DE passed away at his home on August 13, 2020. He was 68 years old. Bud was born on August 25, 1951 to the late Joseph A. Moore, Sr. and to his mother, Pauline Elliott Moore, who survives him, in Dagsboro, DE. He married his sweetheart, Malinda Ray McCabe in 1982 at the Hickory Hill Church and together they raised a son, Joseph A. Moore, IV. Bud was a veteran of the US Army, serving overseas in Germany. He also served as a Deputy in the Sussex County Sheriff's office. He went to work at Delaware's Department of Transportation, retiring after 32 years of service.
