In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made to Compassionate Care Hospice or The Delaware Veterans Hospital.

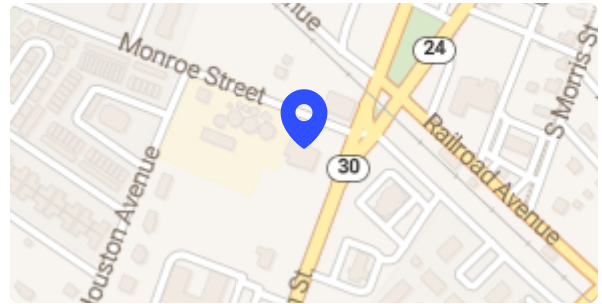

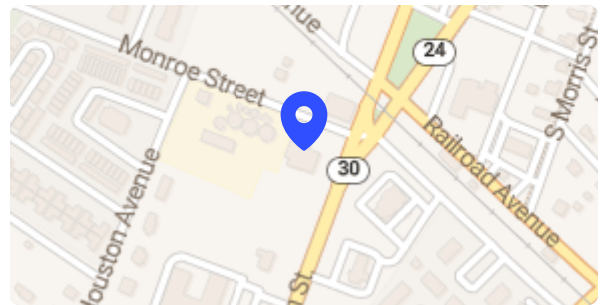

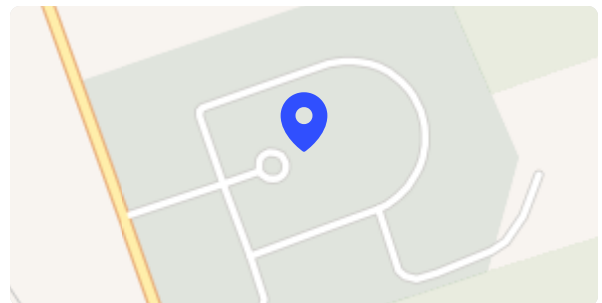
